

Regina Health Center Celebrating Our 30th Anniversary

Regina Health Center was a pioneer as one of the first intercongregational skilled nursing and assisted living facilities in the United States when it opened in 1993 in Mount Augustine, the motherhouse for the Sisters of Charity of St. Augustine that was built in 1955. In the early 1990s, the Sisters raised more than \$7.5 million to renovate and convert much of the facility, collaborating with 22 Catholic religious congregations to ensure the long-term health care needs of religious sisters, brothers and priests would be met with high-quality health care services in opening Regina Health Center.
